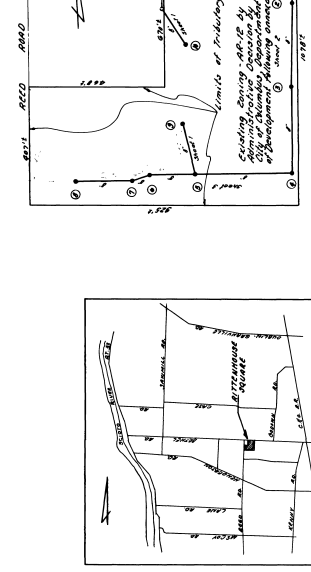
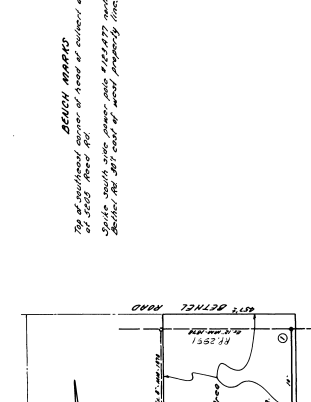


**GENERAL NOTES**

The Construction and Materials Specifications of the City of Columbus, Ohio, dated Jan. 1, 1971, shall govern all construction items in the vicinity of the work indicated under this project of existing subsurface structures of record and shown in any other drawings. The contractor shall strictly adhere to a maximum trench width of 48" when working in areas adjacent to existing structures. All trenching shall be done in accordance with the above. 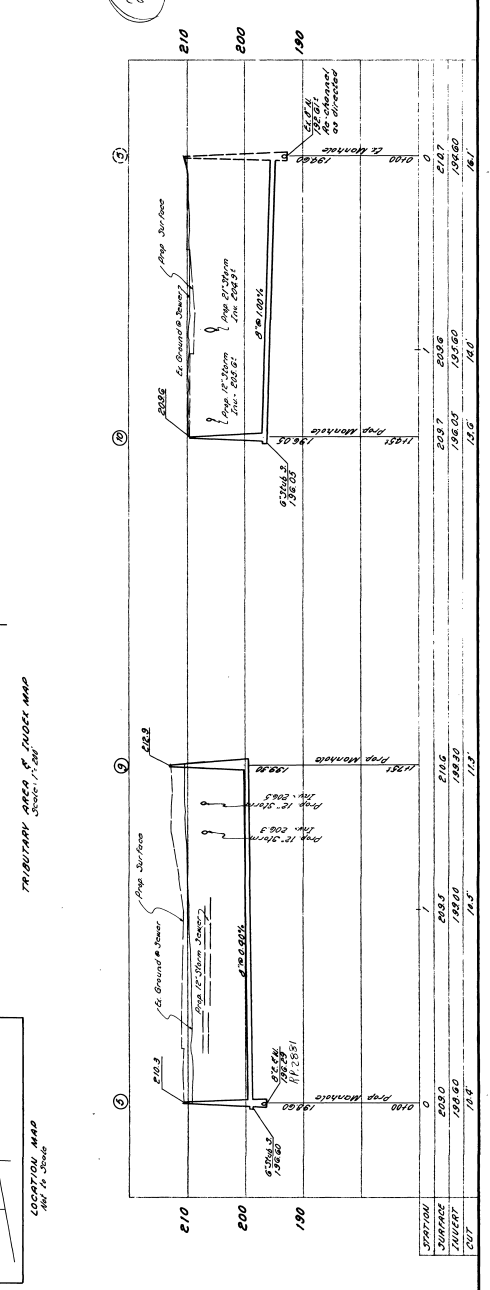
